The West Texas Symphony (WTS) was founded in 1962, as the Midland-Odessa Symphony & Chorale. Under the direction of Maestro Gary Lewis, West Texas Symphony includes a professional symphony orchestra with over 70 musicians, a large adult chorale, over a hundred-member youth choir, and three resident instrumental ensembles: Lone Star Brass, Permian Basin String Quartet, and West Texas Winds. Celebrating our spectacular 60th Season, the West Texas Symphony holds the distinction of being one of the largest professional performing arts organizations in West Texas.

Wid you know?

The production of a single West Texas Symphony concert may cost as much as \$70,000. Some of our expenses include: music conductor, orchestra personnel, guest artists, music rental & royalties, piano tuning, printed programs, venue rental, production staff, and instrument transport.

If we relied on ticket sales alone to cover concert expenses, the cost of a single ticket for our patrons would prohibit many from enjoying the presentation of live symphonic and choral music in the Permian Basin.
