



# Take 3 to headline MOSC fundraiser

The Midland-Odessa Symphony and Chorale, currently in its 57th season, will host its annual fundraiser on Thursday. The trio Take 3 will headline the fundraiser at Midland Community Theatre.

For previous fundraisers, big headliners such as Asleep at the Wheel, The Ten Tenors and Home Free performed at the Wagner Noel Performing Arts Center.

“Midland Community Theatre as the venue offers an intimate setting for this exciting trio performance,” MOSC executive director Jeanette Kolokoff said in an email.

With onstage charisma and instrumentation, the all-female Take 3 performs a setlist that includes pop hits, jazz, movie themes and classical music signature pieces through violin, cello and piano. Beyond performing, the women’s mission is to use their artistic ability as an avenue for storytelling, according to a press release.

“I jumped at the opportunity to book a performance of Take 3 while they are on tour. This will be the first time that this dynamic trio has performed in the Basin and we are in for a treat,” Kolokoff added. “Our annual fundraiser supports the operations of the Midland Odessa Symphony and Chorale. Ticket sales only covering 22 percent of our expenses. Special events, donations and sponsorships are critical to allowing us to continue to enrich lives through music with excellence.
